THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT

Made available more than \$90.6 million to Louisiana to invest in home and community-based services to expand access to care for seniors and people with disabilities and raise wages for workers.¹

Over 85% of all Louisiana seniors are vaccinated, better protecting them from COVID-19.²



Protection for Residents

Made available more than \$8.6 million to help protect nursing home residents from COVID-19.



Senior & Caregiver Services

Provided a \$8.5 million investment to support older adults and family caregivers in Louisiana.⁴



Food Security

Secured a \$9.9 million investment to provide nutritious meals to seniors in Louisiana.⁵



Combating Elder Abuse

Allocated landmark funding to better protect the one in ten older Americans who experience a form of elder abuse in a given year.⁶



Help for Grandfamilies

Established a National Technical Assistance Center to help the more than 54,000 grandfamilies raising grandchildren in Louisiana.⁷
